 - Luke 6:37
 - James 4:11-12
 - James 5:19-20
3. According to verse 4, what is intended to lead one to repentance?
4. How do you think God's kindness can lead someone to repentance?
5. How has God shown kindness to you?
6. According to verse 5, what is causing the storing up of God's wrath against some people?
7. How do we avoid the wrath of God? Where do you go in the Bible to support your answer?
