How Does God Judge the Moralist?

1. God Judges Based on Knowledge (Romans 2:1-3)
2. God Judges Based on the Heart (Romans 2:4-5)
3. God Judges Based on Deeds (Romans 2:6-10)
4. God Judges Based on Impartiality (Romans 2:11-16)

PRAY

OPEN

1. What is your main take away from this week's message? How did God speak to you?
2. How have you seen God's goodness over the last week? Share good news with your group.

READ, HEAR, & LIVE THE WORD OF GOD

Read Romans 2:6-16

1. What is the main lesson being taught in verses 6-10?
2. Verse 6 states that God "will repay each person according to what they have done." Then in verses 7-10, two types of people are described. Contrast them below.
3. To which person described in versus 7-10 do you most relate to and why?
4. What main point is being made in verses 12-16?
5. Using just the verses in today's lesson, what benefit does the law have in a person's life?
6. According to today's text, does God show special favoritism to either Jew or Gentile? Explain your answer.
7. What lesson or principle from today's text will you ask God to help you apply to your life?

PRAY FOR YOUR FAMILY & FRIENDS

As we study these truths over the coming weeks, think of some family members or friends who do not know God and commit to praying for their salvation.

- Spend a few minutes asking God who He wants to be on your list.
