2. How have you seen God's goodness over the last week? Share good news with your group.

## **READ, HEAR, & LIVE THE WORD OF GOD**

### **Read Romans 5:6-11**

1. What is meant in verse 6, "Christ died for the ungodly?" (Hint: Use verse 8 to help with your answer.)
2. According to verse 9, how is one saved from the wrath of God?
3. These verses talk about "reconciliation." First, what does this mean and why is "reconciliation" necessary between mankind and God?
4. When did you realize you needed to be reconciled to God? What happened that brought you to that point?
5. Read Romans 5:6-11 again. How does this passage encourage you? How would this passage be helpful when sharing Christ with a friend?

## **PRAY FOR YOUR FAMILY & FRIENDS**

Think of some family members or friends who do not know God and commit to praying for their salvation.

- Spend a few minutes asking God who He wants to be on your list.
- Write their names down on paper and place it in your Bible as a bookmark for Romans.
