1. What is your main take away from this week's message? How did God speak to you?
2. How have you seen God's goodness over the last week? Share good news with your group.

READ, HEAR, & LIVE THE WORD OF GOD

1. According to verse 12: How did sin enter the world? How did death enter the world? To whom did death come and why?

2. What do you learn about mankind's sinfulness from the following verses?

Read Romans 5:15-19

3. From what man did the trespass come? From what man did the gift come?

4. What was brought into the world from the one sin? What was brought into the world by the one gift? (Hint: Use verse 16.)

5. According to verse 17, what reigned through the trespass of Adam? What reigned through the gift of God through Jesus Christ?

6. Verse 19 is a good summary of today's passage. Write a summary in your own words.

7. What principle from verses 15-19 can you apply to your life?

8. What do you think "where sin increased, grace increased all the more" means?

9. How might verses 20 & 21 be applied to your own life?

10. What is the main point being made by verses 20 & 21?
