STUDENT MINISTRY OVERVIEW

Mission: Our mission is to help every student (6th-12th Grade) FIND & FOLLOW Jesus.

Goal: The primary purpose of the Student Ministry is to develop and implement a student ministry for 6th-12th grade, which helps them CONNECT to Christ, CENTER their lives on Christ, discover their CALL in Christ, and CHANGE the world through Christ. As part of this goal, the Student Ministry empowers and equips parents/guardians in the spiritual growth process of their students.

STUDENT MINISTRY LEADERSHIP

Position: Student & Social Ministry Pastor

Description: Provide the chief visionary leadership and oversight to the Student Ministry for all students in the 6th-12 grade range. The leader of this ministry implements ministry strategies that help students, and their families develop a foundation of faith that will last a lifetime.

A secondary role for the Student Pastor is to work with the church staff as the leader to help develop a more concise and coordinated effort in our social ministry strategies.

Responsibilities:

STUDENT MINISTRY

1. Develop a clearly defined vision and strategy for disciple-making within the Student Ministry that works in conjunction with the overall vision and ministry of CenterPointe C.C.
2. Bring inspiration to the vision of the Student Ministry.
3. Build and develop a Dream Team for the Student Ministry, consisting of essential committed and gifted volunteers.
4. Recruit, train, and oversee all Student Ministry volunteers. The goal is to equip "God's people to do works of service," as Ephesians 4:12 instructs.
5. Develop and implement a strategy for whole-family disciple-making, working with families to equip and empower parents/families to disciple their students.
6. Work with your team to develop dynamic student-friendly environments.
7. Research and implement needs and trends in student development and education.

8. Provide oversight and planning for all aspects of Student Ministry programming.
 - a. Sunday Morning Experiences, Classes, and scheduling
 - b. Specialized Classes
 - c. Curriculum selection/development for all programming
 - d. Purchase & maintain supplies
 - d. Outreach events
 - e. Family events, classes, opportunities
 - f. Camps, Retreats, Serve Opportunities
9. Provide oversight to the Student Ministry Budget and help develop the budgetary needs for upcoming years.
10. Create & Implement a process to help students make salvation decisions to follow Jesus.

SOCIAL MINISTRY

1. Help create, edit, publish, and share consistent, relevant content (original text, images, video, or HTML) that creates meaningful moments of connection for our online community
2. Equip and organize photography and social media volunteer team
3. Daily interaction with our online community through intentional messaging and comment and response management
4. Help expand the reach of CPCC through other social media platforms
5. Develop a team to connect with the online worship gathering community helping them find and follow Jesus.
6. Work with leadership to help develop, establish, and maintain annual marketing strategies to meet ministry objectives.

TEAM LEADERSHIP

1. Work as a team player with the rest of the CenterPointe Leadership, Pastoral, Elders, Support Staff, and Ministry Team Leaders. Make every effort to attend all leadership functions (i.e., staff meetings, leadership meetings, retreats, planning sessions, etc.)
2. Participate and provide support and leadership (when necessary) in church-wide events, even if they do not directly affect the Children's Ministry.
3. Share in the responsibility of ministerial responsibilities, like counseling, visitation, hospital visits, etc.
4. Communicate with church staff, leaders, & church body about ministry plans, events, and opportunities. Communicate, communicate, communicate!

5. All CPCC staff members are expected to be involved in Corporate Worship, CP Groups, Regular Giving (Tithe & Offerings), and volunteering.

Personal Qualifications:

1. The Student Minister must have a personal, dynamic, and growing relationship with God through Jesus Christ.
2. Has a strong understanding of God's Word and can explain the truths of Scripture.
3. Has identified strengths, weaknesses, spiritual gifts, blind spots and is open to accountability to growing and improving in these identified areas.
4. Have a deep love for students while balancing grace and truth as you work to help them find and follow Jesus.
5. Is approachable, loving, and welcoming to students and families in all walks of life.
6. Physically capable of sustained activity.
7. Able to balance ministry life & family.

Professional Qualifications:

1. Leadership
2. Administration & Organization
3. Preaching/Teaching/Public Speaking
4. Computer & Technology
5. Demonstrates strong conflict management and public relation skills
6. Understanding of Cultural Norms
7. Not necessarily required, but helpful to have a University degree in leading students and, more specifically, towards an area of ministry to students.

Benefits & Compensation:

- Salary and benefits are considered depending upon the experience of the individual.
- An annual review will be implemented for ministry development and compensation provided.

Expectations:

1. **Hours Per Week:** 45-50hrs
 - This ministry is not 9-5. Ministry to students usually occurs afternoons and evenings at the schools, sporting events, plays, concerts, and church. We want someone who desires to build influential relationships with the local community to impact students and their families.
